

World Health Report: Health Systems Financing



Launches Providing for Health (P4H) with twin goals:

- Equitable social health
 protection
- Sustainable and efficient health financing systems

First time WHO synthesizes actions countries can adapt to modify their financing systems for UHC International Labour Organization: <u>Social Protection</u> <u>Floors Recommendation, 2012</u> (No. 202)

2012

Provides guidance to countries:

- (i) in establishing and maintaining national SPFs as a fundamental element of their national social security systems and
- (ii) in implementing their floors within strategies for the extension of social security that progressively ensure higher levels of social security to as many people as possible, guided by ILO social security standards.

United Nations: Sustainable Development Goals



193 countries commit to working together towards the common UHC target (health financing outlined in Indicator 3.8.2)


Bridging the gap between social health protection and health financing is essential

P4H Coordination Desk


- Supporting function to the P4H Steering Group and Technical Exchange Group
