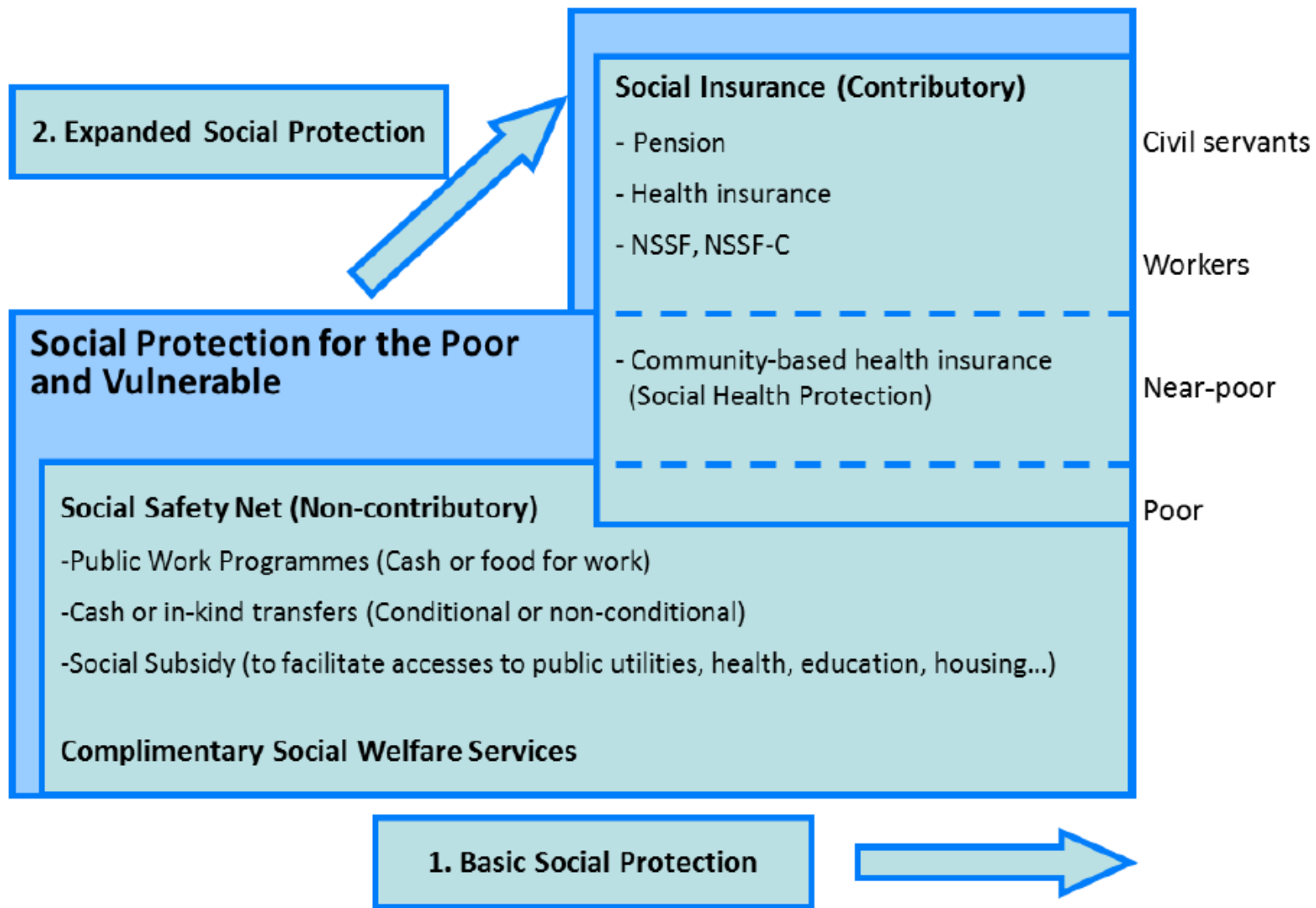
What are the issues to be addressed?

- ❖ NSDP 2014-2018: RGC is committed to a development process that will ensure a “better quality of life”
- ❖ Infant Mortality Rate, Under-five Mortality Rate and Maternal Mortality Rate have shown visible progress
 - ❖ There is the challenge of sustaining indicators that has succeeded until so far
 - ❖ Some indicators like child malnutrition, water and sanitation are still constricted



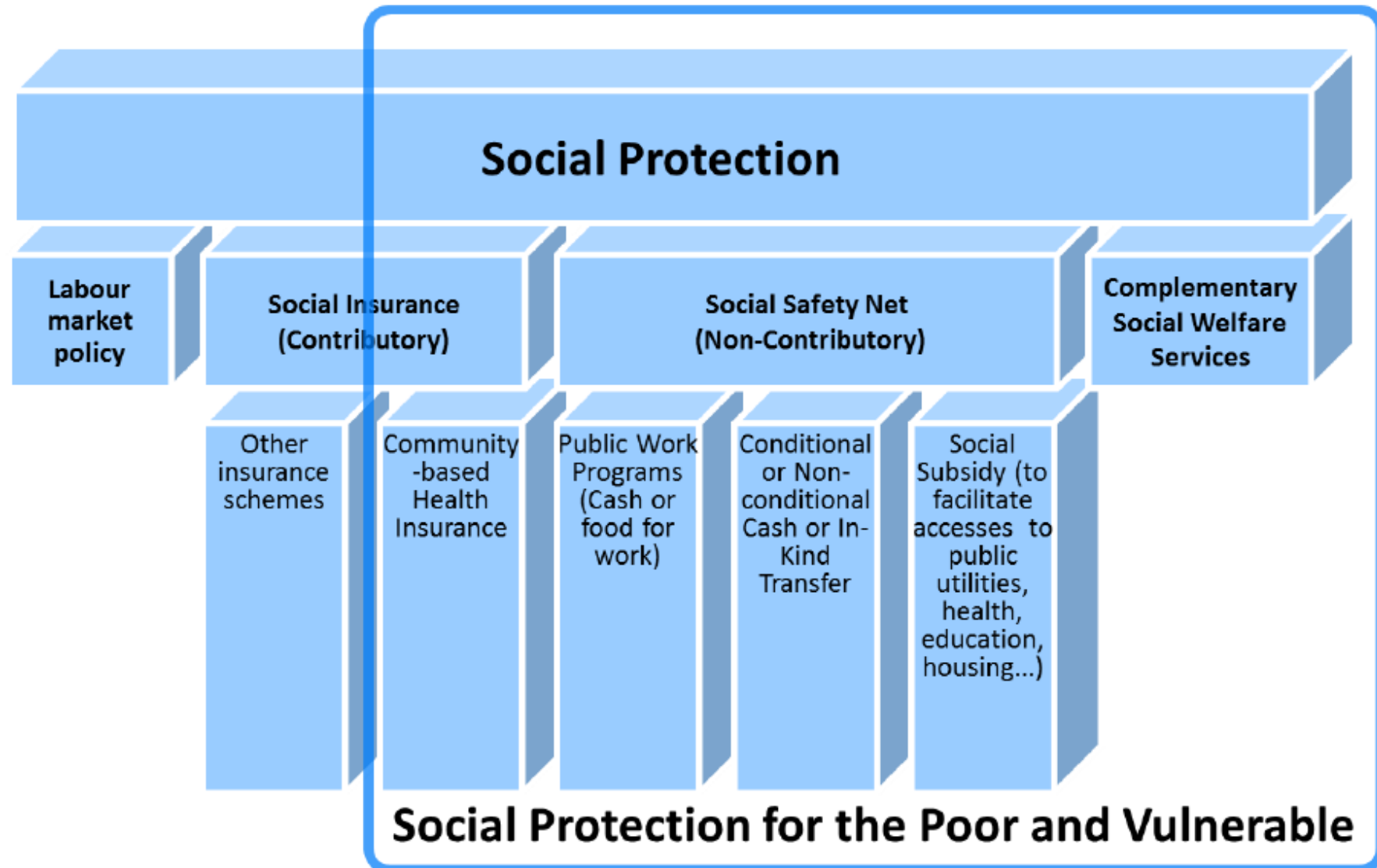

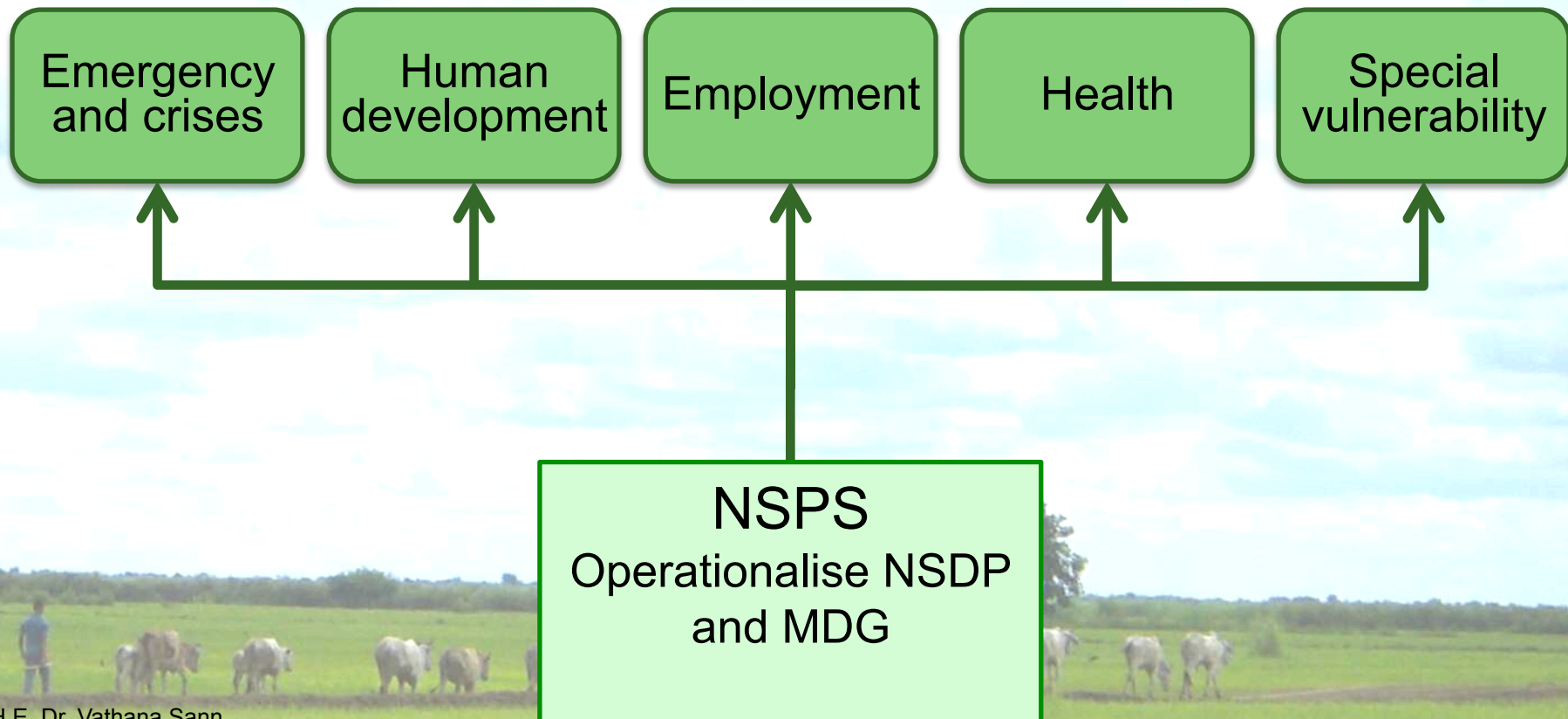

Implementation (challenge)

- ❖ NSDP had identified social protection tools for the pillar of human development
 - ❖ Strengthening the ID-Poor Programme
 - ❖ Rolling out the NSPS with special reference to PWP and cash-transfer schemes,
 - ❖ Promoting a micro-nutrient strategy, through the health and education service delivery systems,
 - ❖ Promoting labour intensive/inclusive economic activities
 - ❖ Training workers and prospective workers in different vocations other than subsistence agriculture





Implementation (challenge)

- ❖ NSDP had identified social protection tools for the pillar of human development
- ❖ NSDP had identified challenges in the implementation of NSPS
 - ❖ Limited coordination between ministries and between national and sub-national levels
 - ❖ Low harmonisation between different development programmes
 - ❖ “Project-based Approaches” are still mostly applied in the implementation of DP’s assistance activities
 - ❖ Limited standardisation in the definitions of indicators and data-generating processes in M&E system



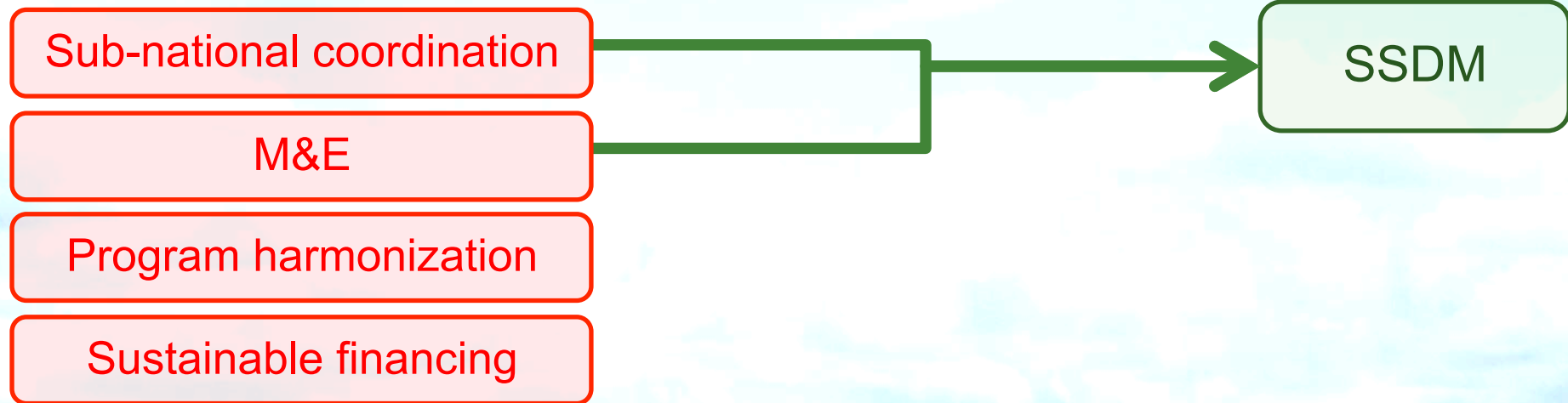

 - ❖ Integrated social protection pilot (ISPP)



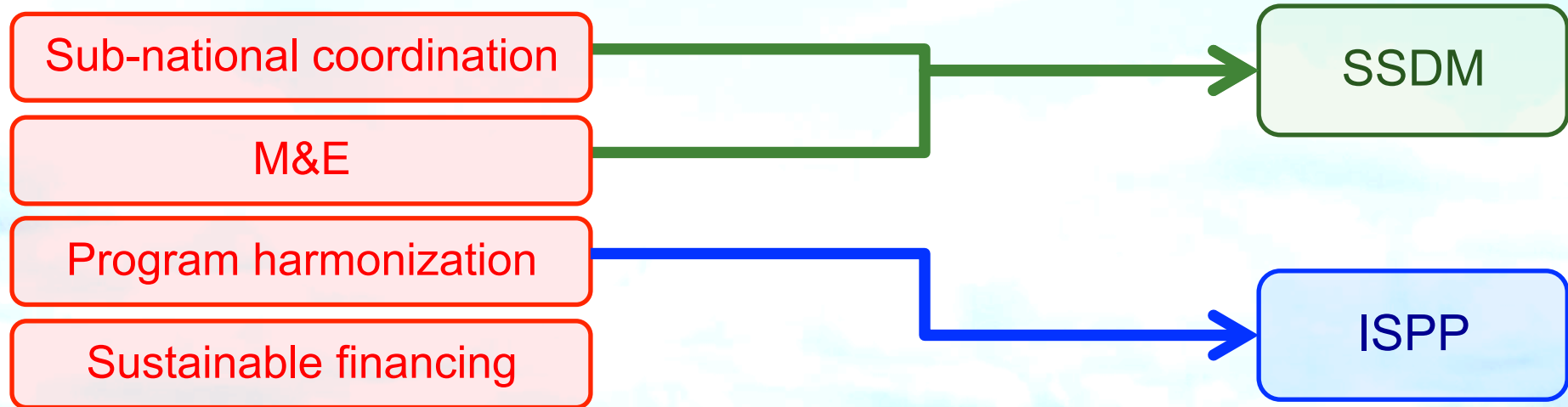

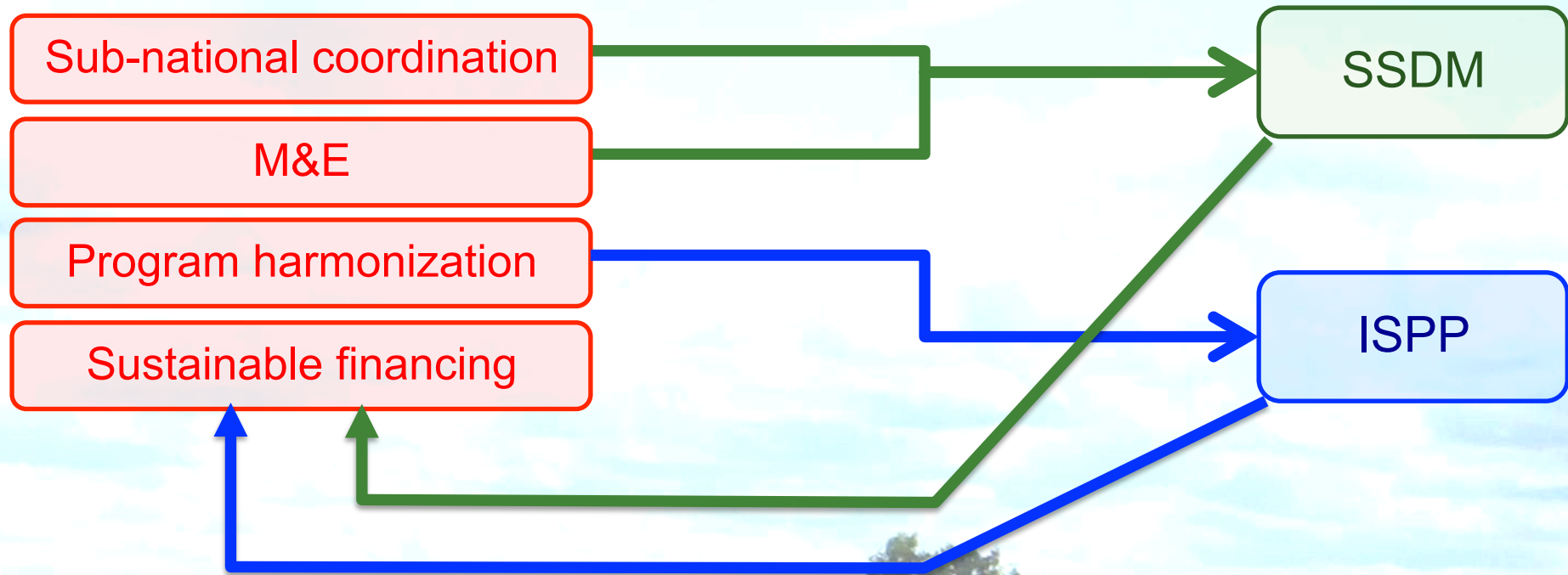

- ❖ Modality of single-window office focused on social service
- ❖ Role and structure of SNA in coordination and accessibility of SP/EMP for the poor
- ❖ Single window of information and application for available SP/EMP
- ❖ Linking national and SNA through a M&E system

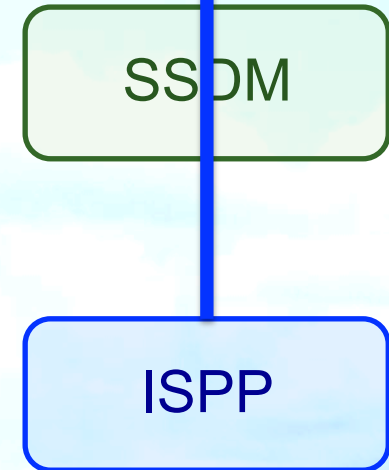

- ❖ The adoption of “Guiding Principle” on SP implementation

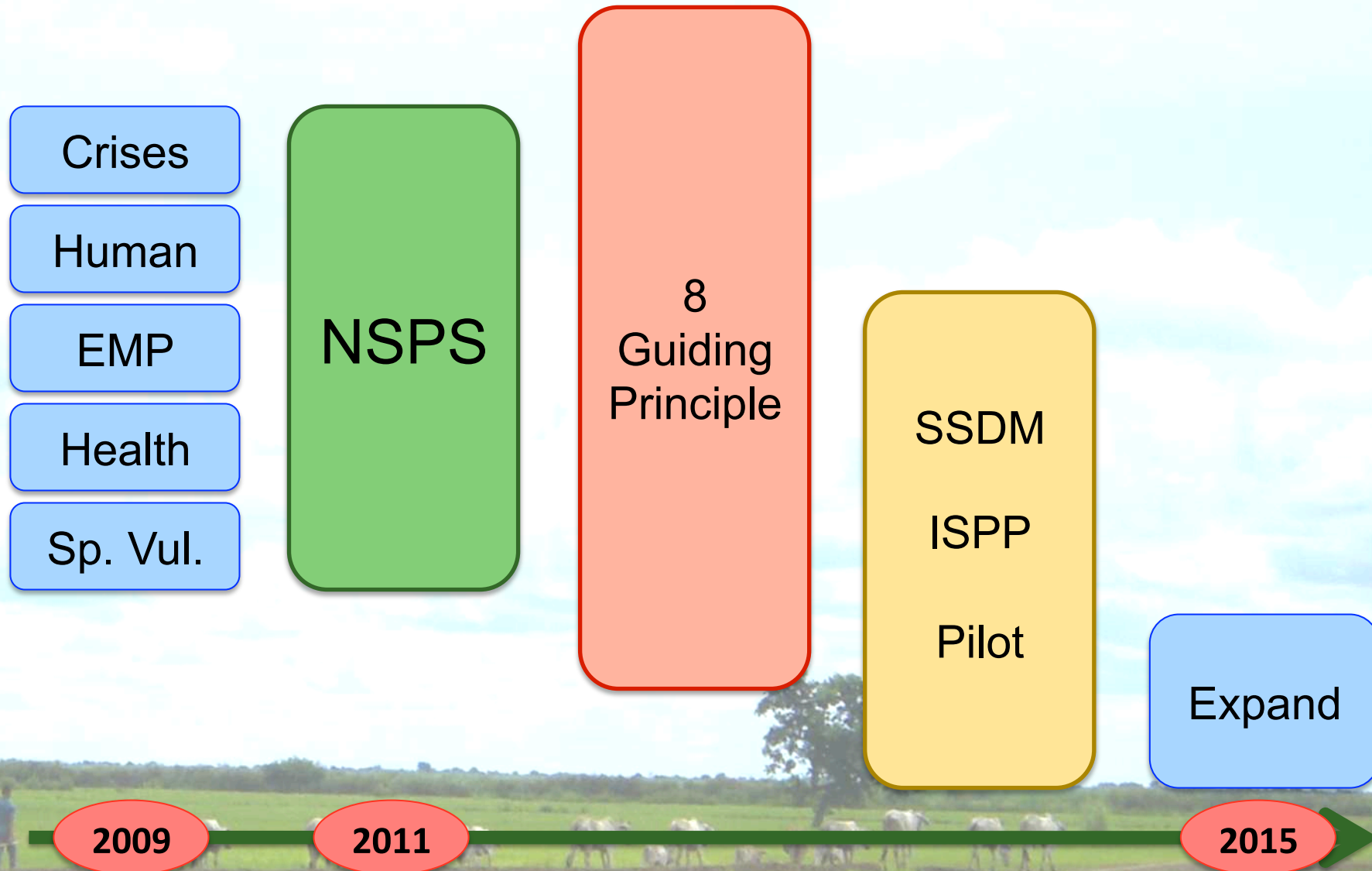

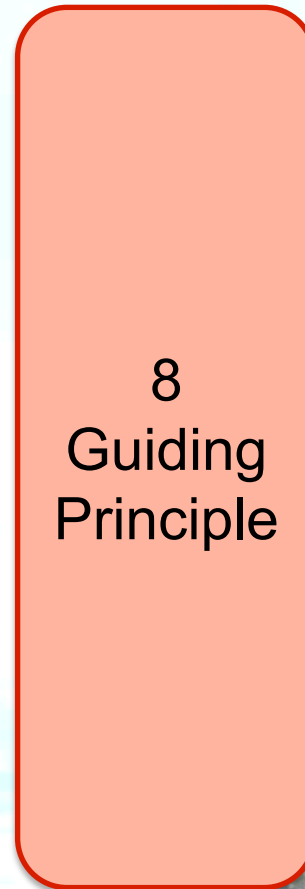
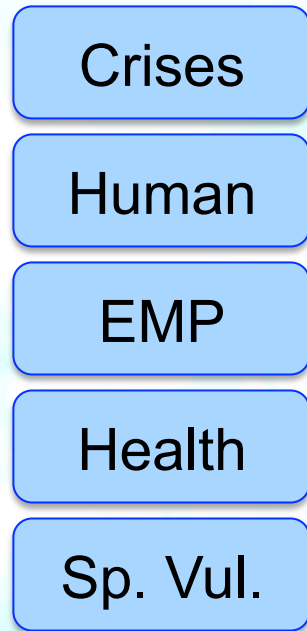
